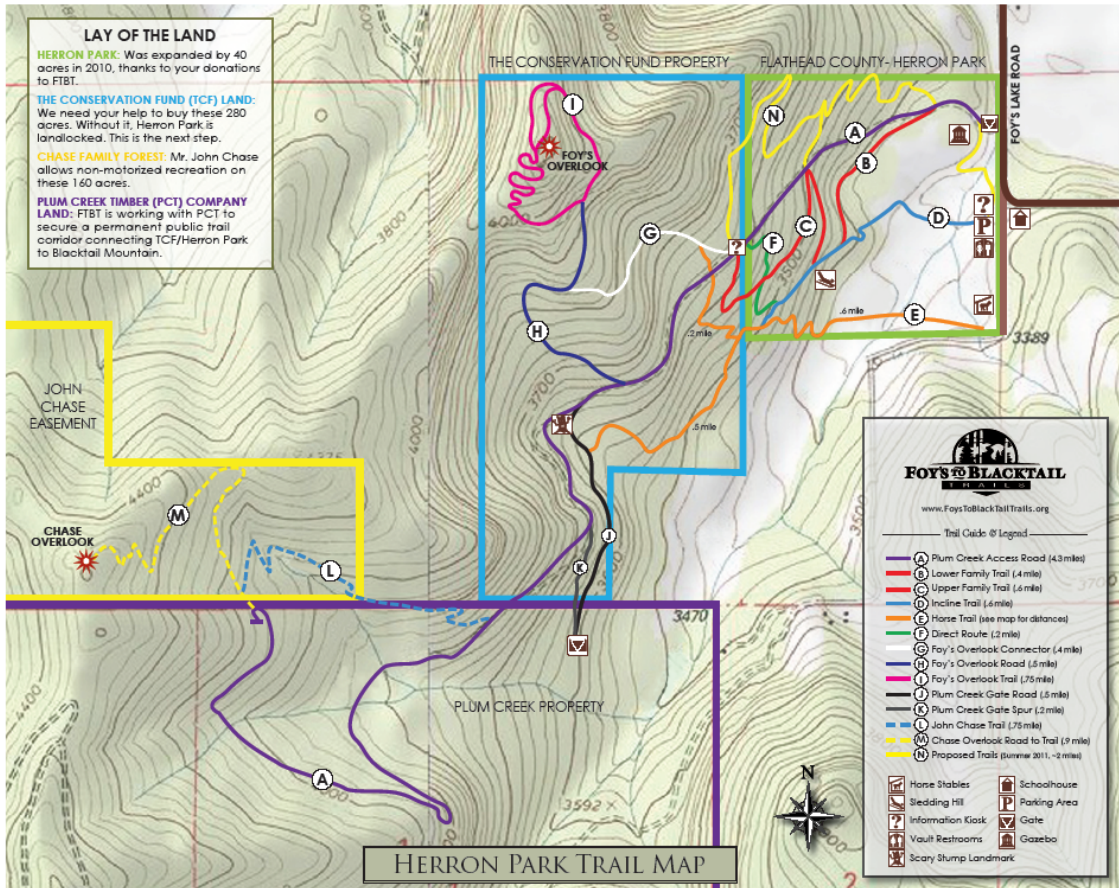
HERRON PARK: Was expanded by 40 acres in 2010, thanks to your donations to FBT.


THE CONSERVATION FUND (TCF) LAND: We need your help to buy these 280 acres. Without it, Herron Park is landlocked. This is the next step.

CHASE FAMILY FOREST: Mr. John Chase allows non-motorized recreation on these 160 acres.

PLUM CREEK TIMBER (PCT) COMPANY LAND: FBT is working with PCT to secure a permanent public trail corridor connecting TCF/Herron Park to Blacktail Mountain.
